Job Description:

The Music Department at Tunghai University, Taichung, Taiwan invites applicants globally for a full-time faculty position that begins in the Fall of 2025.

For Voice position:

Candidate will be expected to teach Applied Voice to both majors and minors at the undergrad and graduate levels, and at least two of the following courses: 1. Graduate Vocal Pedagogy; 2. Italian, German, French, and English Song Literature; 3. Italian, German, French, and English Diction for Singers; 4. Opera Workshop. The candidates should have the ability with teaching courses in voice-related subjects, participating in the development of the department, recruitment, and to guide or counsel students with academic writings, graduate theses, and career development.

For Vocal Coach position:

Candidate will be expected to have the ability to coach bel canto singing style and technique. Candidate will be expected to teach Voice Coaching Lessons to both majors and minors at the undergrad and graduate levels, and at least two of the following courses: 1. Italian, German, French, and English Song Literature; 2. Italian, German, French, and English Diction for Singers; 3. Musical coaching for Opera Workshop. 4. Coaching the Recitative Passages. The candidates should have the ability with teaching courses in voice-related subjects, coaching opera scenes, art songs, and chamber ensembles with voices, participating in the development of the department, recruitment, and to guide or counsel students with academic writings, graduate theses, and career development.

Qualifications: Applicants should have at least one of the following qualifications:

For Voice position:

1. An earned doctoral degree in voice or related fields, or an equivalent to the doctoral degree according to the Ministry of Education, Taiwan, Rule 16-1, 17, 18¹.
2. Assistant professorship, Associate professorship, or full professorship with legal documentation.

For Vocal Coach position:

1. An earned doctoral degree in vocal coaching or related fields, or an equivalent to the doctoral degree according to the Ministry of Education, Taiwan, Rule 16-1, 17, 18².
2. Assistant professorship, Associate professorship, or full professorship with legal documentation.
3. A Master's degree in vocal coach with nine years of working experience as a professional coach or répétiteur at an opera house/theater in the US or Europe

For Voice position:

1. Curriculum vitae with records of performances and publications.
2. A photocopy of diplomas. If the degree was earned outside of Taiwan, the diploma is required to be attested by a government representative office or overseas missions.
3. Official transcripts for all graduate studies.
4. If applicable, a photocopy of the teacher's certificate of rank as issued by the Taiwan Ministry of Education.
5. Requirement of recordings of performances: a). A minimum of 50 minutes of music. b). Must include music sung in Italian, French, German, and English. c). Must include music from Baroque, Classical, Romantic, and 20th or 21th century style periods. All recorded performances must have been made within the past three years.
6. Teaching materials for perspective courses, including course descriptions, syllabi, teaching outlines and any applicable materials.
7. Two letters of recommendation and references with contact information.

For Vocal Coach position:

3. Official transcripts for all graduate studies.
